Track Coaches/AD's:

The Minocqua J1 School District (MHLT) will be hosting the Eighth Annual Mary Terese Hartzheim Memorial Middle School Track Invitational on Tuesday, May 8, 2018. The coaches meeting will start at 3:00 pm. This meeting will be for scratches and replacements only – no additions. The field events will start at 3:30 pm with running events starting at 4:15 pm.

The entry fee will be \$120.00 per coed school which will be used for trophies, timing services, and medals. We will be also using White River Sports out of Iron River, WI to ensure accurate and efficient results. Send your entry fee of \$120.00 before the day of the meet to Jim Ellis, Athletic Director, Minocqua J1 School District, and 7450 Titus Drive, Minocqua, WI 54548. Coaches can enter their lineups on itiming.com. The event will open approximately one week for the invite and be closed the day before.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

1. All races will be seeded on a 400 meter track and run on metric times and distances. The track has a rubberized surface. Spikes of ¼” or less can be used. All running events, high, triple, and long jump runways are rubber surfaces. The shot put and discus areas are made on concrete. There is no pole vault.
2. All running events will be run as finals. **Three entries per event and one relay team per relay event.**
3. The field events: triple and long jump, shot put, and discuss, will have four jumps or throws in, no trials. We will use the open pit concept.
4. Awards:
 - a. 1st place team trophy for both boys and girls
 - b. Medals: 1st, 2nd place individual and 1st, 2nd place relays
 - c. Ribbons: 3rd-6th place individual and 3rd-6th place relays.
5. There will be a concession stand and bathrooms near the track for the convenience of both athletes and spectators.
6. The following schools will be sent letter of invite: Arbor Vitae-Woodruff, Lac du Flambeau, North Lakeland, Tomahawk, Mercer, Phillips, Hurley, Merrill, Northland Pines, Chequamegon, Rhinelander, Antigo, Prentice and Three Lakes. The invitational will be able to accommodate up to 10 teams.
